

DHEERAN RULES FOR ASSESSMENT

- * Attendance is compulsory for all assessments held during the year, failing which the student will be given zero. Consideration whatsoever will be only on genuine medical grounds, that too at the sole discretion of the Principal only, after the parents submit an application on the day of the exam at school office.
- * A minimum attendance record of 90% of the total number of working days in each term / unit is compulsory. In the eventuality a student misses classes due to health reasons, the school will have the sole discretion waiver, if any.
- * There is no provision for reassessing students, who remain absent on the day of the assessment, or those who have failed in one or more subjects. Request for change in assessment dates or timings will not be entertained.
- * Students reporting late for assessment will not be given any extra time for answering the question papers.

For Parents To Parent The Child (Parenting Tips)

- 1. Check the diary daily.
- 2. Provide a congenial atmosphere to learn at home.
- 3. Make sure that your ward is completing assignment of the particular day.
- 4. The visit to school once in 15 days to discuss regarding your wards only to the class teacher behavior and academic performance in the school.
- 5. Make sure that your ward is going to school in a perfect uniform.
- 6. Don't use abusive language at home also if you noticed that your ward is using any abusive language, inform to the school immediately.
- 7. Don't allow the child to carry money, mobile phones, cameras, any other electronic gadgets or expensive items to the school.

Absence from School

- a) Student who are been absent on the previous day will be allowed to attend class by stating the reason for the absence.
- b) In case a child reports to school without an explanation, then the parents will be summoned to school.
- c) In case of absence of more than two days on Medical Grounds, Medical Certificate & prescription shall be attached along with application.
- A student, returning to school after suffering an infectious or contagious disease, should produce a doctor's fitness certificate permitting her / him to attend school. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to school.

Chicken Pox	Till the scars fall completely	Not > 15 Days
Cholera	Till the child has completely recovered	Not > 15 Days
Measles	Two weeks after the rash disappears	Not > 10 Days
Mumps	Until the swelling has gone	about one month Not > 15 Days
Whooping Cough	Till the doctor certifies	Not > 20 Days
Hepatitis	Till the doctor certifies	Not > 20 Days

Parents will be promptly informed in the event of serious illness or emergencies and may be requested to come to school to take their ward home if necessary.

- e) Repeated absence without notice or unexplained absence without written application for more than six consecutive days renders the student liable to have her/his name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may only be granted after payment of a re-admission fee.
- f) All students are expected to attend school on the opening day immediately following the vacations. Absence on the day of reopening of the school will be taken to a strict disciplinary action.
- g) It is compulsory for students to achieve 90% attendance in each term inorder to be eligible to take the end-of-term assessment. This stipulation can only be relaxed on genuine medical grounds, at the sole discretion of the Principal.

Late Arrival to School

- a) Students are expected to reach school 10 minutes before the start of the school.
- b) Students arriving late will not be allowed to enter the school premises without a plausible explanation.
- c) Students found to have come late for more than three days in a term will not be allowed to attend classes on forth such occurrence and disciplinary action shall be taken against them.

School Transport Rules

Sl.No.	Particulars	Remarks
1.	It is mandatory for all the students to avail has bus facility from this session except for students residing in nearby areas.	
2.	Parent should contact the school transport incharge for necessary details or any changes desired.	
3.	Students are not allowed to go behind or under the buses parking in the school campus. Students are also not allowed to sit in parked buses during school hours.	
4.	A student using the school bus is expected to be at the bus stop at least five minutes before the scheduled arrival of the bus. The student has to be on the correct side of the arriving bus.	
5.	Students are allowed to use only their allotted bus and bus stop. There is no provision for temporary change in bus or bus stops.	
6.	Students who miss the allotted bus, should not try to board any other bus. In such cases it is the responsibility of parents to drop their wards to the school. Such students may, however, return by their allotted bus.	
7.	Unruly behavior like shrieking and shouting is strictly prohibited. The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.	
8.	The drivers are authorized to stop buses at designated stops only, unless otherwise directed by the bus teacher.
